Richard Hayde from Cappa died in 1927 and left his estate to Mary Hayde, spinster (his daughter – see 1901 census).

Mary died in 1945, a spinster, and left the estate to a non Hayde. William, her brother predeceased her and died in 1942 and also left his estate (PDS 128) to a non family member. This seems to imply that John (an unmarried Uncle) predeceased them.
