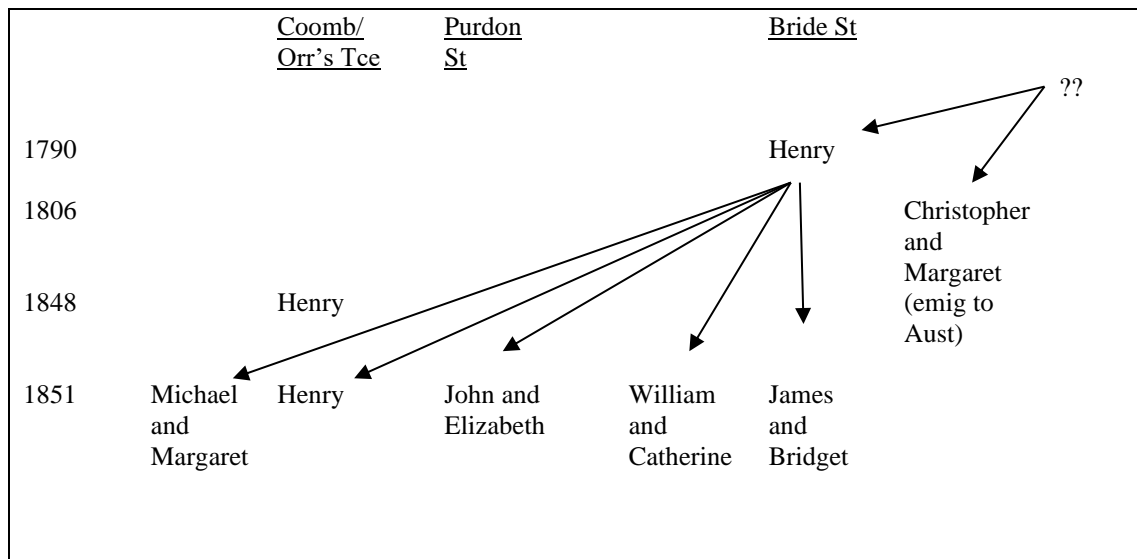

## Freemen of Dublin City 1774-1824

These are tradesmen and craftsmen, including tailors, weavers, and carpenters, as well as masters of other branches of the fine and applied arts that were recognized as citizens and afforded the rights and responsibilities of a citizen, including the right to vote and being subject to the laws of Dublin.

## 1826 Labourers accounts

In 1826 there was a major bank crisis in England which resulted in many textile factories in Dublin becoming uneconomic. Many of these factories closed and the staff were unemployed. Many of the newly unemployed men were used to repair roads in various parts of Dublin during the summer of 1826.

## Tithe (1830s)

There were no relevant Tithe records.

## William Smith O'Brien petition 1848

In 1848, a William Smith O'Brien from Limerick was the leader of a rebellion against British rule. This started at The Commons in Ballingarry, Tipperary and culminated in his capture at Thurles and sentence to death at a court in Clonmel. A petition for his clemency was started and resulted in his sentence being commuted and his being transported to Australia as a convict. Those people from Dublin who signed this petition were:

## Entitlement to Vote in Ireland

Until the third decade of the 1800s, Catholics could not hold public office including the position of Member of Parliament. When in 1829 this demand, known as Catholic Emancipation was conceded, so that Catholics (and dissenting Protestants and Jews for that matter) could hold public office, the electorate in Ireland was radically cut so that Catholics

would not dominate Protestants. In a population of c.8 million the electorate was cut from 216,000 to 37,000 men as the property qualification for voting was raised from 40 shillings to £10 income per year.

Catholic emancipation in other words represented, in the short-term anyway, one step forward and two steps backwards for democracy in Ireland. However, it did establish the principle that all male subjects of the realm were equal before the law.

In 1832 the Representation of the People (Ireland) Act extended the the right to vote by including £10 freeholders, those who held leases for life and leaseholders of at least 60 years.

In 1850, the Reform Act gave the vote to every man with total property of 12 pounds, raising the electorate to c.16% of adult men in Ireland.

It was extended slightly in 1867. In 1872 the secret ballot was introduced so people did not have to fear reprisals, especially from landlords, for their votes. The 1884 Representation of the People Act lowered the property threshold again, so that about 30% of the adult male population had the vote (compared to about 60% in England, where incomes were higher).

### Voters in 1857 City of Dublin Elections

These elections are the earliest where records of voters have been kept.

- 5 Oct 1883. Elizabeth Mary Hayde was charged with theft but was acquitted. (possibly b 1865, dau of Thomas and Jane Kearney **Tree # 16**)
- 3 Sept 1887. John Hayde of Marlborough Street was prosecuted for selling buttermilk that contained in excess of 20% of added water. (prob 139 Francis St **Tree # 3**)
- 30 May 1892. The entire household furniture and effects of Patrick Hayde at 95 Lower Baggot St were to be auctioned. Patrick was moving to the country owing to ill health. **Tree # 18**. (Patrick died 3/7/1893 aged 75).

There were no entries for Heyde, Hide and Had. Checked all Hyde entries but none were relevant.

## Bureau of Military History – War of Independence

Various records are available from this time period. The only relevant entry is in HOWS/774 and is for a witness to events concerning ‘D’ Company Dublin Brigade 1917-1921, specifically to do with the burning of the Custom House, Dublin 25 May 1921.

The records refer to a Dan Heade who died during this incident.

The Military Service Pension index of the 1916-1923 period records him as Daniel Joseph Head b 9 July 1903 and died 25 May 1921. The pension was applied for by Mary Head, his mother. Michael Head was his father. His birth place was given as Customs House, Dublin. He was a carpenter and his address was given as Ballybough Rd, Dublin.

I don’t think he is linked to any Heade family.

## Other Sources

The Irish Times, on 5 October 1912, recorded that a William Hayde from 5 Brookfield Road, Kilmainham was fined 10s for assisting a Patrick Cahill bury a child (Matilda Cahill) in an unauthorised graveyard. (**Tree #3**).

Patrick was a labourer while his father Patrick was a shoemaker. Parish records state that Patrick was the son of Patrick and Ellen from Longstown (Ballymore Eustace). Thomas and John from Crehelp, Co Wicklow (see Wicklow) were also shoemakers. They started families in the 1860s.

Patrick Hayde, a labourer from Whitechurch, Willbrook, Rathfarnham died in 1909 aged 84 (b 1825). He left his estate to a non family member. He was a widower aged 68 (b 1833) in 1901 census. He was in prison in 1877 and his records stated that he was from Merginstown, Wicklow. Merginstown is by Mullycagh Lower.

William Hade from Rathfarnham (b 1849) enlisted in the army (36<sup>th</sup> Foot) in 1867. He married Mary Aggett and was discharged to Dublin in 1892. He was probably the son of Pat and Cath – see Rathfarnham parish records.

James from Fethard married in 1899 was also a shoemaker. I can find no other connection between these families. However, as very few Haydes were anything other than farmers and labourers I feel that there must be a connection somewhere.

## Conclusion

It appears that in the late 1800s there were a few Hayde families either close together in the city center or in suburbs to the south. They were mainly labourers and were probably attracted to the city at the time of the famine and the difficulties finding work in the rural areas in the early to mid 1800s. They all appear to originate from Kildare/Wicklow area as the trend at the time was to move to the cities from rural areas.

The early families appear to be:
