Conclusion on Dunnamaggan Families

John and James at Moanmore in 1827 were probably brothers who went there looking for work. Moanmore is at the foot of a mountain that stretches into Tipperary. These brothers probably came from a Tipperary family and moved around the mountain. I can find no descendants in Ireland or England. They either immigrated to America or adopted one of the surname variants. As they were somewhat distant from other parts of the family they could have used a variant without knowing any difference.
