

Patrick married Ellen and had 5 children, Two were surviving by 1900 – Thomas (b 1884) and Ellen. Thomas married Dora and had a son Thomas.

The parents of Thomas were Patrick and Ellen from Crehelp (see Roundwood parish). See also Pat and Eliz in Willbrook.

Thomas had the same occupation as John in Crehelp who had a family around the same time. They were probably brothers/cousins and Thomas moved to Roundwood to marry and have a family. His son Dennis went to Liverpool in the 1880s with sisters Mary and Julia. John was probably the son of John and Rose and was born in the 1830s when the records were faded.

James Hade from Dragonhill, Hollywood, died in 1866 aged 81 (born 1785). Patrick and Catherine christened their first child in 1840 James. He was probably named after the James born in 1785 who was probably the father of Patrick.

The Irish Times

An article in 4 March 1909 referred to a court case in the Chancery Division, before the Master of Rolls.

It concerned a Patrick Hayde (aged 86) and his brother Thomas Hayde (aged 76) from Roundwood, Co Wicklow, who were claiming to be second cousins of the late Archdeacon Keogh P.P. and were therefore entitled to a share of his estate.

They established that they were second cousins of the deceased priest.

Thomas is clearly the husband of Mary Cahill, the son of Patrick and Eleanor Keogh from Crehelp.

Other Newspaper Articles

Freeman's Journal:

- 5 Oct 1892. T Hayde was listed as attending a meeting of Nationalists of West County Wicklow in Roundwood. (This is probably Thomas, the husband of Mary Cahill).

Conclusion

In the 1700s there were three Hayde families in the area. William and Anne (Scalp area), Richard and Hanna (Newtown area), Julies and Rosa (Blackhill). I have assumed that they were brothers (born around 1760) and have also assumed that their parents were Laurence and Bridget (after their first borns). This is however a guess.

The DNA of a descendant is similar to that of Hayde families from Tipperary. There is therefore a link to Tipperary that has yet been found.

Conclusion

Thomas and Ann Ging had a family in this area in the 1840s. They probably moved to Barkersford from either the Ballymore Eustace/Dunlavin area or from Tipperary.

John Hayde, who enlisted in the British army at Athy in 1855, listed his next of kin as his mother, Annie. John was born in 1840 and is a brother of Patrick. John died in 1864. His father, Thomas, had probably died by 1855 so John presumably joined the army to survive.

I have linked this family to **Tree # 3**.

This branch of the family seems to have died out.
