

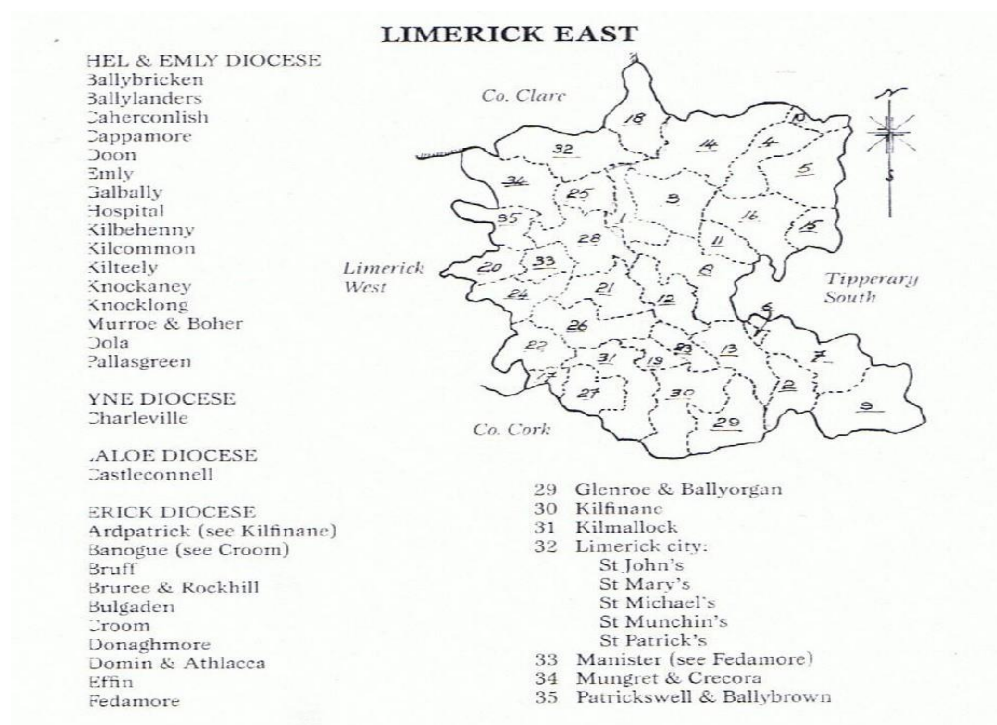

RAF 1912 – 1939

These records have a Henry Heade b 1874, Moroe, Limerick. He was C of E and served as a valet and butler 1918-20. He was 44 when he enlisted. His NOK was his mother Mary from Moroe. This would be the Mary in Moroe in the 1901 census.
