#### Wills

The will of Richard Hayde from Ratoath, County Meath, who died in 1876, showed that he was a publican and left his estate to Anne Hayde. This is probably Rich and Ann Crosby m 1866.

### **Newspaper Articles**

Freeman's Journal:

• 9 Oct 1878. Ann Hayde, a bankrupt who was the owner of a licenced house in Ratoath, was the subject of a court case. This is probably the wife of Richard above. References were also made to a niece Maryann Brannigan and her mother Mrs Johnston.

#### Slaters

This had a record in 1870 of Richard Hayde, a grocer from Ratoath.

### Conclusion

In 1659 there were 6 Head families in Ratoath, Dunshaughlin.

I do not know if these Meath families are linked to families I other parts of Ireland. Nor do I know their origins.

It is possible that they are from a family that moved north from Dublin.

Given the presence in the area in 1659, it is also more likely however that the Hade, Heade, Hayd, Hayde references found in the records in this area come from a Head family with no have no connection with the families further south.

DNA testing of a descendant will be the only way to prove or disprove any linkages. However, there are no known living descendants from these families.

### Conclusion

It seems that at some time between 1830 and 1854 Nicholas and his son Nicholas, together with other members of the family arrived in Duleek. They were labourers rather than farmers

and they presumably went there in search of employment. They lived in the town, on the Commons by the Moat. Their descendants emigrated to America.

Duleek is situated on the main road between Dublin and Belfast. It would be logical to assume that they moved to the area in the early to mid 1800s from Ratoath. DNA testing has shown a link to Tipperary and Dublin Hayde families.
