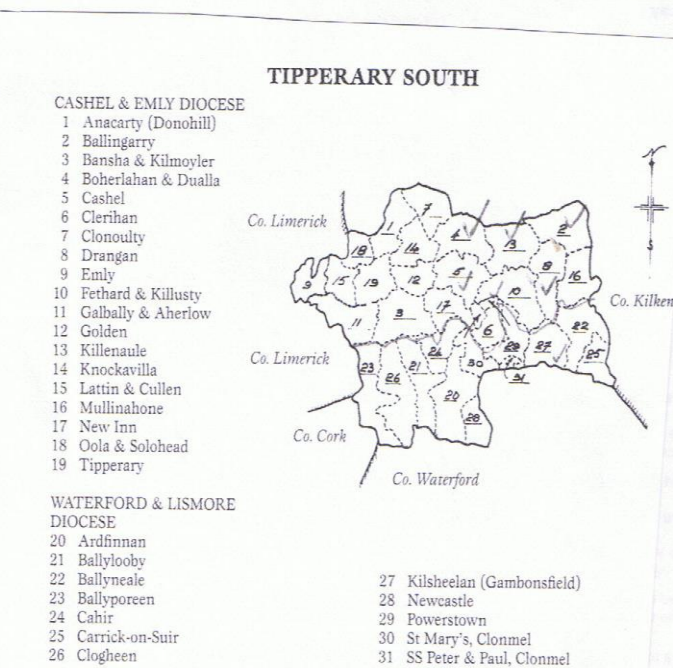
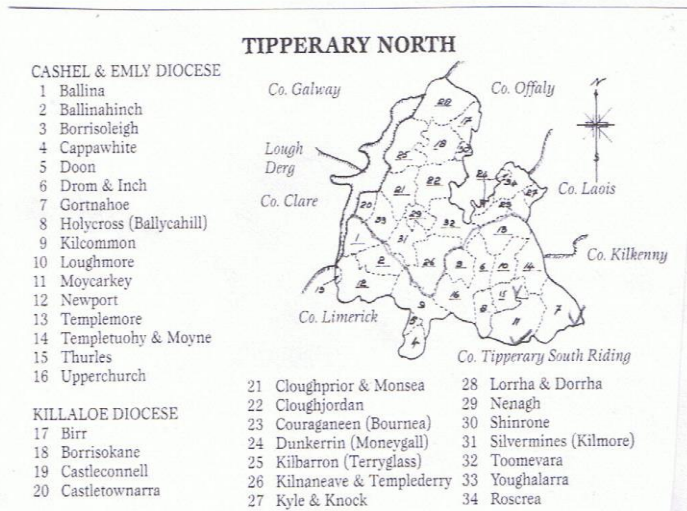



Tipperary North Families (Tree # 7)

Galbertstown Lower is 5 miles south of Thurles. Borris and Leigh are a similar distance east.

Kilduff is in the foothill of Kilduff mountains, NW of Templemore. There was no sign of this family in the Tithe and Griffiths records however in the Griffiths at Farenderra, Templemore were Tim, Mich, Pat and Thos Headen. It is possible that these families are linked.

Littleton is just south of Borris and Leigh and was also a civil parish.

Also noted in records were:

- Mary Heade from Cabra who married in 1811
- Mary Hade from Moycarky who married Joseph Fanning in 1841. Mary is daughter of Margaret Hade who died 1868 and who was from Parkstown, Littleton.
- John and Honaria Hade sponsors 1858 in Gralla
- John Hade and Honaria Hayde sponsors in 1862

Grallagh is just south of Moycarky and 3kms north of Ballinure. Leigh and Borris are close together on the road to Urlingford from Killenaule. (See also Pierce, Urlingford 1876). Moycarky civil parish includes part of Gortnahoe, Templemore and Thurles Catholic parishes.

New Street is probably in the town of Thurles However there is also a street of this name in the town of Littleton.

Pat and Jude also had John b 1811. John's father Patrick was recorded as a clerk on his marriage cert. John married in England in 1837 and was in Leamington, Warwickshire in 1841, 1851 and 1861.

The parents of Patrick who married Mary Roach were Matthew Hade and a J or F Ryan according to a translation of the original entry of his death records in the Channel Islands. He died 1898 aged 76 (b 1822). Mary died 1891 aged 68 (born 1823). These birth dates are consistent (within a year) to ages in census records. The original entry was probably Patt and this has been translated as Matt (Matthew). They first appeared in the Channel Islands census in 1851 with a child born Ireland 1848 which means they left Ireland 1849/1850.

They probably originate from Borris and Leigh given how the children have similar names. Nicholas could be g father, Patrick the father and Pierce an uncle.

An extract from a Tipperary archives image (Walkers Hibernian Magazine) included a Miss Hayde from Kilduff, Limerick, who married John Smithwick in 1791. She was the daughter of Richard Hayde from Castleleak³, Co Tipperary.

Also in the parish were:

- Sarah Head from Kilduff who had a child to Martin Dwyer in 1836
- Thomas Head sp in 1838
- Michael Heade sp in 1840
- Mary Heade from Kilduff who had a child (James Heade) to a protestant out of wedlock in 1860 (sp was Mary Mahony so this was prob Mary b 1839)

The family in Kilduff from 1831 to circa 1847 didn't feature in the Tithes (1827) records. They have a DNA match to Tree # 1 from Tipperary.

Civil Registration and Wills – Thurles District

³ This is probably Castleleiny, south east of Templemore on the road to Urlingford.

In the Thurles district the death of a Thomas Hayde in 1864 was recorded. He was aged 46 (b 1818), a bachelor and a constable in D Division Dublin. See also records of Dublin Met Police.

Margaret Hade d 1868 aged 82 (b 1786). She lived Parkstown, Littleton. She was a Cottier (peasant farmer) and a widow. Mary Fanning was her daughter.

Landed Estates Court

The sale of a lot in Galbertstown in 1857 showed a James Hayde as a tenant of 10a 0r 21p. He had a 7 year lease from the Court of Chancery.

Conclusion on Tipperary North

The families in Tipperary North in the early 1800s probably originate from areas in Tippetray South and reflected the movements north in the 1700s.

There is no sign of anyone in the area after the 1860s. Surviving families were in:

- Lancashire, England from 1850s
- Channel Islands circa 1850 to 1890s

- Detroit from 1880s
- Bolton and Worcestershire to early 1900s
