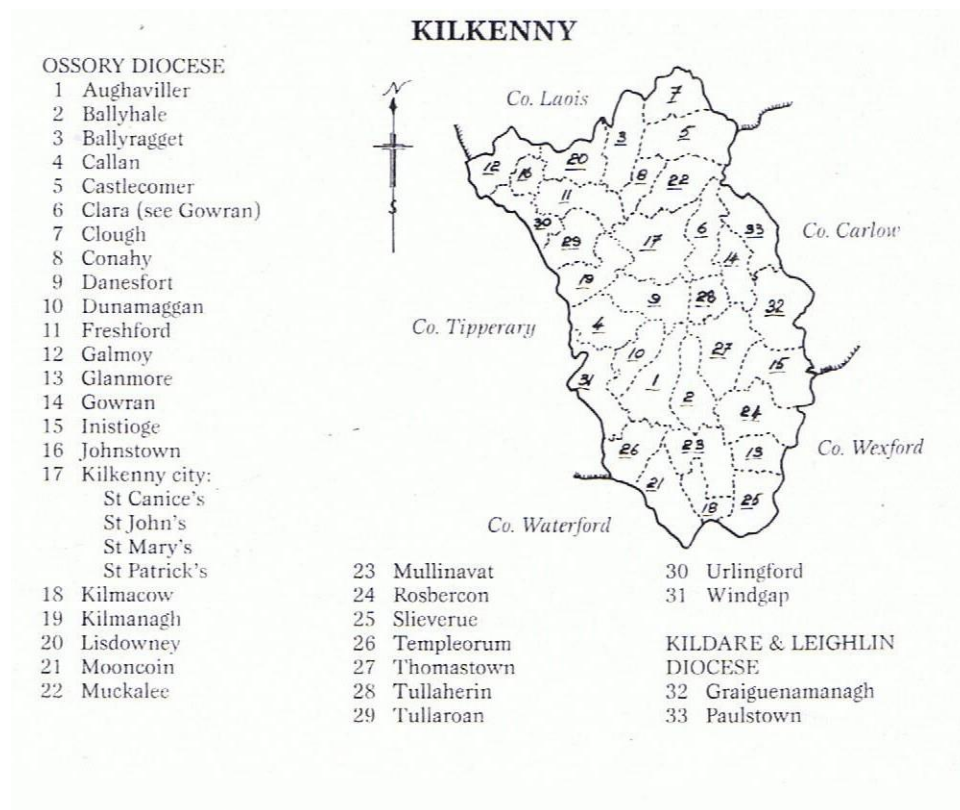

Also in this parish were the marriages of:

- Nell (Ellen) Head to William Butler 1829
- Ally Head to Martin Dunn 1853 (ie Alice b 1820)
- Mary Heade to John Sutton 1855 (wit by Catherine Wiley – prob nee Heade b 1818), Lisdowney
- Mary Heade to John Maguire 1858 (wit by Mary Wiley, dau of Catherine Heade). Mary married John Sutton then remarried John Maguire. (Lisdowney in 1901 census)

Whitegate is 4.5 miles SW of Lisdowney, Parksgrove is 2 miles east and Skinstown is 2 miles south. Foyle, Ballen, Ballygowney and Frankford are all close to Whitegate.

The farmers in 1830 of Nicholas Head (Seskin) and Martin Head (Lisdowney) don't feature in the parish records above so they are presumably parents.

Conclusion on Urlingford Families

John at Lisdowney and James at Tubbrid were some 15kms apart around the foothills of a mountain. Tubbrid is 7 kms north east of Kilcooly Abbey. The descendants of John and James either stayed in the area (mainly Urlingford) or went to Dublin.
